UPDATE FROM THE BOARD

Hello Friends and FCE Supporters,

Welcome! This is our 5th year in existence and we continue to persevere in executing our mission for the benefit of all. We are excited to share with you our plans for the rest of this year.

As we embark upon a new growing season, we will engage with our community members to create healthier and safer environments for us all to live. Our priorities include launching the Earth Skills Vocational Training Pilot Program (summer 2018), energizing our organic land care initiative as we engage homeowners, municipalities, and businesses to adopt safer practices in caring for their land, and collaborating with key stakeholders to overcome the many environmental challenges which we face.

Our funding needs include purchase of organic land care equipment (250-gallon rig sprayer & trailer) to provide beneficial compost tea applications that will in turn create unique vocational opportunities for our earth skill participants while also reducing pesticide use in our communities. On site at our greenhouse in Beverly (located at Long Hill Reservation), an upgraded solar panel system for our aquaponic/organic land care needs is necessary. Lastly, FCE is planning to operate our summer pilot program with all volunteer/internship members, but to continue this program into the fall/spring, additional funding will be necessary.
